The renowned actress Laura de la Uz of Havana, Cuba, will visit Towson University during the third week of November 2014. She will introduce the screening of her most recent film, *La película de Ana*, directed by the late Daniel Díaz Torres. This screening is promoted by the Cuban Institute of Film Arts and Industries (ICAIC), as part of its 55th anniversary. She will also interact with Towson University students in two open classes, talking about Cuban film and theater since the 1990's and about her career as an actress, delving into gender and political issues in Cuba today.
