A talk with Norma Guillard and Jan Strout

Norma Guillard, at age 15, participated in Cuba's Literacy Campaign, which later became a model for Venezuela's own. She discusses the role women have played in the two countries' social programs, and the struggle against domestic violence and machismo.

Jan Strout is a co-chair of the U.S. Women and Cuba Collaborative Project and a national board member of NOW. She has worked to build ties between Cuba, Venezuela and the U.S. In 2003 her delegation met with President Chavez, and she has participated in two conferences in Caracas of the Women's International Democratic Federation.
